Senator Klobuchar and her staff are looking for qualified applicants to work in the state of Minnesota. Minneapolis interns assist the office in a variety of administrative capacities. Interns support constituent services and outreach staff by conducting casework-related tasks, including sending inquiries to federal government agencies, contacting constituents for more information, and drafting letters for events and constituents. They also assist the outreach and communications staff with research, event planning, meeting preparation, and processing and organizing event invitations. During your time in the office, you will gain a deeper knowledge of the federal government and help make a difference by serving the people of Minnesota.

Eligibility

The ideal student applicant will have strong academic credentials and an interest in politics. Students and recent college graduates with ties to Minnesota are strongly encouraged to apply. Students from all academic disciplines are welcome. We ask that interns plan to work at least 15 hours a week during the course of the internship.

Application

To apply for an internship, the following must be submitted as a complete package. We highly recommend that you retain a complete copy of your application packet. Your completed application should include:

- Current Resume
- Short Writing Sample
- List of Three References
